Year-after-year, the TBDMSA expands. Since 2019, the TBDMSA has grown by 65% making it the largest softball/baseball user-group in the area.




















TBDMSA AGE DIVISIONS



















COMPETITION

HOUSE LEAGUE

The TBDMSA is essentially a "House League" meaning we do not have travel teams so all games are played locally in Tottenham and Beeton.

The level of competition varies but for the most part, games are played for fun. Due to the size of our community, it is very likely that your child will know other players from school or other sports so comradery is very common.

Teams will play once a week on a designated time slot while all teams have practice times available to them. Teams in the U7, U10, U14, and U19 divisions will have practices that may occur once a week or every other week depending on your Coach's decision.

U5 teams will have a practice followed by a twoinning game where every player will have the opportunity to bat during the regular schedule.

There are no championships awarded in U3, U5 and U7 as these divisions are meant for player development and fun.

This low level of commitment provides parents the opportunity to allow their families to enjoy other activities throughout the summer.

INFORMATION TO HELP PARENTS

THE ROLE OF THE TBDMSA

From registration, scheduling umpires, soliciting sponsorship, providing opportunities for player development to ball diamond bookings with the municipality, the TBDMSA is a volunteer-based organization that enable players, parents, coaches and fans to enjoy softball in our community.

WHEN DO WE PLAY?

The Town of New Tecumseth will release the use of ball diamonds based on the weather conditions and physical conditions of the diamonds typically around the second to third week in May. Our schedule will typically start around this time.

Games start promptly at 6:30 pm and last a maximum of 1 hour and 25 minutes. U14, and U19 divisions also play under the lights at 8:00 or 8:30 pm.

HOW ARE REGISTRATION FEES BASED AND USED?

Player registration fees are used to offset costs of ball diamond permit fees, equipment, umpires, development programs, awards, team photographs and uniforms.

Older age-groups will see higher fees than younger ages primarly due to the use of lights and senior umpires. We are fortunate to have wonderful support from our sponsors who offset our expenses with generous contributions to our Association. Without their support, we would be forced to increase our rates.

The TBDMSA is a not-for-profit organization so all funds are allocated back to the organization.





RISK MANAGEMENT A SAFE PLACE TO PLAY

Assessing and managing risk to provide a safe and enjoyable experience for our participants is a big part of our job. The TBDMSA is insured through Ontario Rural Softball Association.

In addition, the TBDMSA mandates several other safety policies and practices including:

- Each team must have at least one coach provide a Vulnerable Sector Check (VSC) from the OPP.
- Each team must have at least one coach take the Respect In Sport Activity Leaders training course
- Following strict playing field condition policies and procedures when it comes to weather conditions to ensure that people do not get injured as a result of the weather.
- Lastly, the Association provides each team with equipment like helmets and catching equipment. Each piece of equipment is thoroughly inspected at the start of the season by the Association Equipment Manager.

With the support of sponsorship funds, the TBDMSA has spent over \$25,000 in the last three years in equipment upgrades.

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

BUILDING SKILLS

Player Development is a priority for the TBDMSA. Sponsorship will help offset costs of delivering skill development clinics and programs. A new initiative in 2025 will be the introduction of a Player Mentor Project featuring softball players aged 18+ working with younger players on skill development.





PITCHING CLINIC SPONSOR

EachFebruary, the TBDMSA offers a Player Development Pitching Clinic. Over 40 players aged 8-19 years old register for the 8-week clinic located at the Tottenham Community Centre. The Clinic is led by a local elite softball pitcher.

Recognizing players for their accomplishments is a rewarding experience. In 2023, the TBDMSA introduced our first-ever U14 All-Star Game.

Players were provided ballots and were responsible for nominating their peers to represent their team in the All-Star Game.

The following year, TBDMSA introduced a second All-Star game to represent the U19 Division. Both the U14 and U19 All-Star games were played at the Help The Kids Play Slo-Pitch Tournament in front of a large crowd of fans providing players a thrill they will always remember.

JR. UMPIRE PROGRAM SPONSOR

Jr. Umpires are between the ages of 12 and 19 years old. They are responsible for enforcing on-field rules and rendering decisions on judgment calls for the U7 and U10 Divisions. Every Jr. Umpire attends mandatory training at the start of the season and a refresher session prior to Playoffs. The TBDMSA employs between 8-12 Jr. Umpires per season.

Jr. Umpires gain valuable skills such as character building, critical thinking, crisis management, confidence and selfworth.
